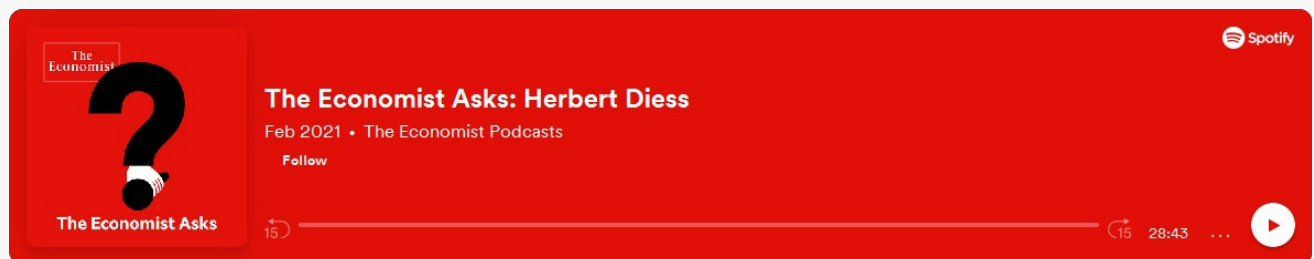


The Economist Asks: Herbert Diess (When will the electric car rule the road)

When will the electric car rule the road?
